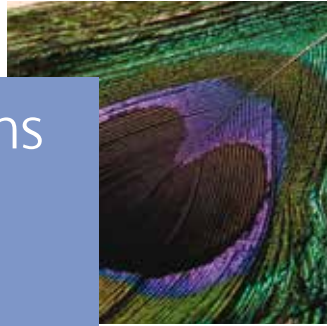


Private actions for antitrust damages
